Group 1: Presenters will recommend answer to borrower; decline if loan should not be made

Group 2: Loan Committee receives presentation; responds and offers criticism

Group 3: Observers provide extensive commentary on presentation and offer improvement

<u>Presenters</u> receive the following: a) balance sheets, operating statements, earned surplus reconcilements; b) description of company; c) loan request

<u>Presenters</u> plan presentation; <u>Loan Committee</u> prepares interrogation; <u>Observers</u> also prepare interrogation and arrive at their own solution.

Presentation is Made: <u>Loan Committee</u> asks whatever it wants and offers suggestions for improvement of presentation. <u>Observers</u> critique both sides.

Instructor suggests 1) facts about the case which should be discussed more completely; and 2) responds to the credit offering by <u>**Presenters**</u> as well as validity of <u>**Loan Committee**</u> response. <u>**Observers**</u> offer comments on work of both groups.
